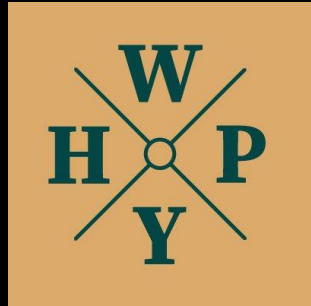

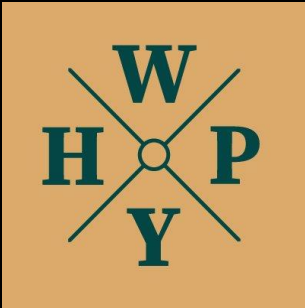

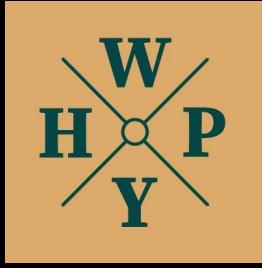


Scaling Up Better Homes Yorkshire



United Kingdom





- 9 housing provider partners, and the Combined Authority as lead
- 1819 individual retrofit measures
- 1316 properties to be improved, with all but five being improved to an EPC-C or better
- Saving an estimated £300,000+ in tenants energy bills, and 2.4million kWh in energy
- Supporting 185 jobs and creating an estimated 5 new apprenticeships
- Total project cost of £10.3m
- Grant funding ask of £5m
